

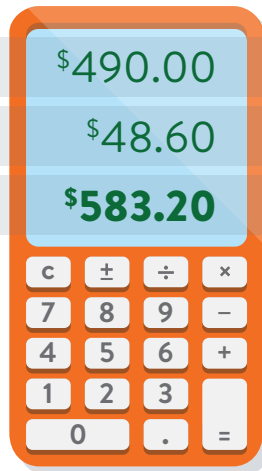

SOCIAL

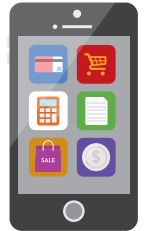

GROCERY LIST
